

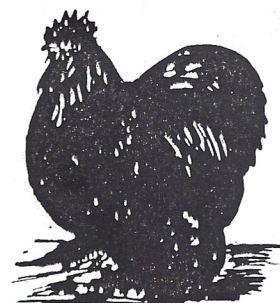

STAYING ON COURSE TOWARD SUCCESS

COLUMBUS NOV. 13,1992

ON FRIDAY NOV. 13, 1992, AT 1 PM A MEETING TO FORM A NEW COCHIN CLUB WAS HELD AT THE OHIO NATIONAL SHOW.

THERE WAS A GOOD TURN OUT OF INTERESTED COCHIN BREEDERS & EXHIBITORS. PAT LACEY INTRODUCED HERSELF TO THE GROUP & PROCEEDED TO INFORM EVERYONE IN ATTENDANCE WHY THE NEW CLUB IDEA MATERIALIZED. SHE & KEITH LEGRAND HAD DISCUSSED THE FAILURE OF RECOGNIZATION & SUPPORT THE TWO CURRENT CLUBS PROVIDED. KEITH ALSO GAVE HIS INPUT FROM COCHIN PEOPLE HE HAD TALKED TO.

AFTER A LENGTHY DISCUSSION IT WAS AGREED THAT A NEW CLUB WAS NEEDED & A NEW NAME WAS VOTED ON BEFORE A BREAK WAS TAKEN FOR PEOPLE TO PAY THEIR DUES TO THE NEW CLUB. THE NAME VOTED FOR THE NEW CLUB WAS "COCHINS INTERNATIONAL"

NOMINATIONS FOR SECRETARY/TREAS. ELTON MINNICH, BARB LEGRAND. ELTON MINNICH ELECTED.

PAT LACEY AGREED TO DO THE NEWSLETTER.

SINCE NEITHER OF THE LOGOS PRESENTED MET WITH APPROVAL, IT WAS AGREED THAT ADDITIONAL LOGOS BE SUBMITTED TO PAT LACEY.

BUDGET COMMITTEE - PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SEC/TREAS, & DISTRICT REPS. THEY WILL SET AWARDS. IN DISCUSSION LARRY PETERSON FELT AWARDS ARE NEEDED, KEITH SAID MOST PEOPLE JUST WANT RECOGNITION AND A GOOD NEWSLETTER, PAT COMMENTED THERE ARE NEW & INNOVATIVE AWARDS OUT THERE, CRAIG THINKS OUR AWARDS SHOULD BE DIFFERENT THAN THE USC. OR WCF. WE NEED SOMETHING NEW.

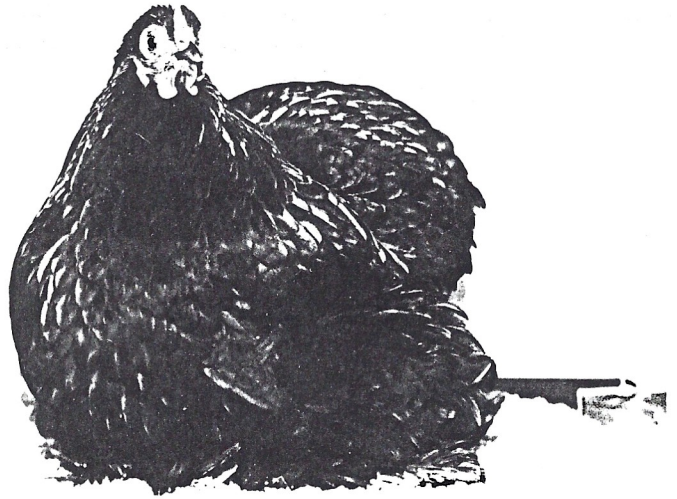

MANY COCHIN BREEDERS AT THE OHIO NATIONAL
THEY ARE ALL HUDDLED TOGETHER FOR WARMTH.

MASTER BREEDER PROGRAM

THE MASTER BREEDER PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO BE SIMPLE TO CALCULATE AND EASY TO FOLLOW. THE PROGRAM IS ALSO DESIGNED TO REPRESENT THE LEVEL OF COMPETITION AMONG COCHINS AND COCHINS ONLY AT ANY GIVEN SHOW. YOU CAN ONLY GAIN POINTS WITHIN THE BREED. THE PROGRAM IS BASED ON 1 POINT FOR EVERY 5 BIRDS SHOWN PROVIDING THERE ARE 2 OR MORE EXHIBITORS SHOWING. THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS 500 POINTS IN NOT LESS THAN 5 YEARS IN ANY ONE VARIETY. A MERIT AWARD WILL BE GIVEN AT 100 POINTS, IN ORDER TO RECOGNIZE THE STANDARDS, COLOR VARIETIES AND FRIZZLES.

COCHIN BANTAMS

FOR EXAMPLE, IF THERE WERE 100 COCHIN BANTAMS AT A SHOW, 40 BLACKS, 40 WHITES, 10 BUFFS, 5 BLUES AND 5 BLACK FRIZZLES, THE BEST AND RESERVE VARIETY BLACK WOULD RECEIVE 8 POINTS EACH. THE BEST AND RESERVE WHITE WOULD RECEIVE 8 POINTS EACH. THE BEST AND RESERVE VARIETY BUFF WOULD RECEIVE 2 POINTS EACH. THE BEST AND RESERVE BLUE WOULD RECEIVE 1 POINT EACH AND THE BEST AND RESERVE BLACK FRIZZLE WOULD RECEIVE 1 POINT EACH.

IF THE BLACK WAS PICKED BEST OF BREED AND THE WHITE RESERVE OF BREED, BOTH WOULD RECEIVE A TOTAL OF 20 POINTS. THIS IS HOW THE COLOR VARIETIES AND FRIZZLES CAN TAKE ALL OF THE AVAILABLE POINTS.

COCHIN STANDARDS

FOR EXAMPLE, IF THERE WERE 20 COCHIN STANDARDS, 5 BLACKS, 5 WHITES, 10 BUFFS, THE BEST AND RESERVE VARIETY BLACK WOULD RECEIVE 1 POINT. THE BEST AND RESERVE VARIETY WHITE WOULD RECEIVE 1 POINT. THE BEST AND RESERVE VARIETY BUFF WOULD RECEIVE 2 POINTS.

IF THE BUFF WAS BEST OF BREED, HE WOULD RECEIVE A TOTAL OF 4 POINTS. IF THE BLACK WAS RESERVE BREED, HE WOULD RECEIVE A TOTAL OF 4 POINTS.

OVERALL CHAMPION

ONCE JUDGING IS COMPLETED IN BOTH BANTAMS AND STANDARD, THE JUDGE WILL PICK AN OVERALL CHAMPION AND HE WOULD RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL 5 POINTS FOR HIS WIN. WITH THE EXAMPLE THAT WE ARE USING THE COCHINS WOULD NOW TOTAL 120. IF THE STANDARD BUFF WAS PICKED OVERALL CHAMPION HE WOULD RECEIVE A TOTAL OF 29 POINTS. OVERALL CHAMPION IS PICKED IN ORDER TO ALLOW THE STANDARDS AN OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE

AGAINST THE BANTAMS. THERE MUST ALWAYS BE 2 OR MORE EXHIBITORS COMPETING.

IF YOU ARE NOT AN NPIP MEMBER A CERTIFIED TESTER MUST TEST YOUR ENTIRE FLOCK AND PROVIDE PAPERS THAT YOUR FLOCK IS PULLORUM CLEAN. IF YOUR PAPERS DO NOT SAY ENTIRE FLOCK TESTED NEGATIVE THE BIRDS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO CANADA. YOUR VET MUST ALSO SIGN AND DATE ALL PAPERWORK. USE FORM (VS FORM 17 - 6) ONLY! AFTER YOUR VET COMPLETES THIS FORM IT MUST BE SENT ON TO YOUR STATE VET. WHO ALSO SIGNS, DATES AND STAMPS IT (IN WISC FOR A \$2 FEE) AND RETURNS IT TO YOUR LOCAL VET. 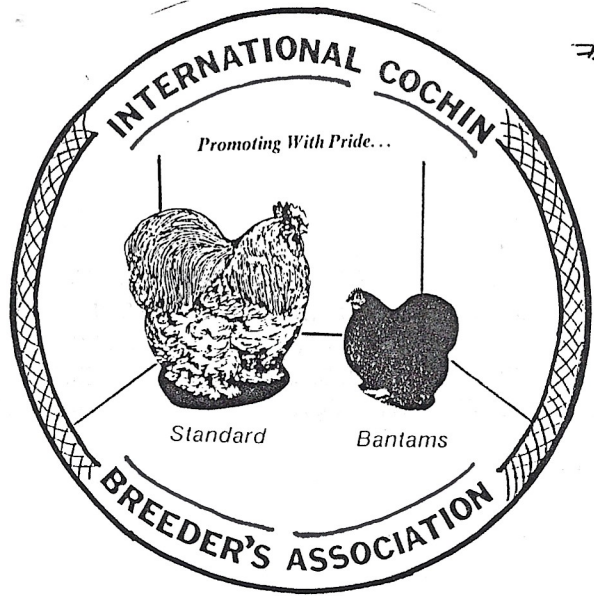

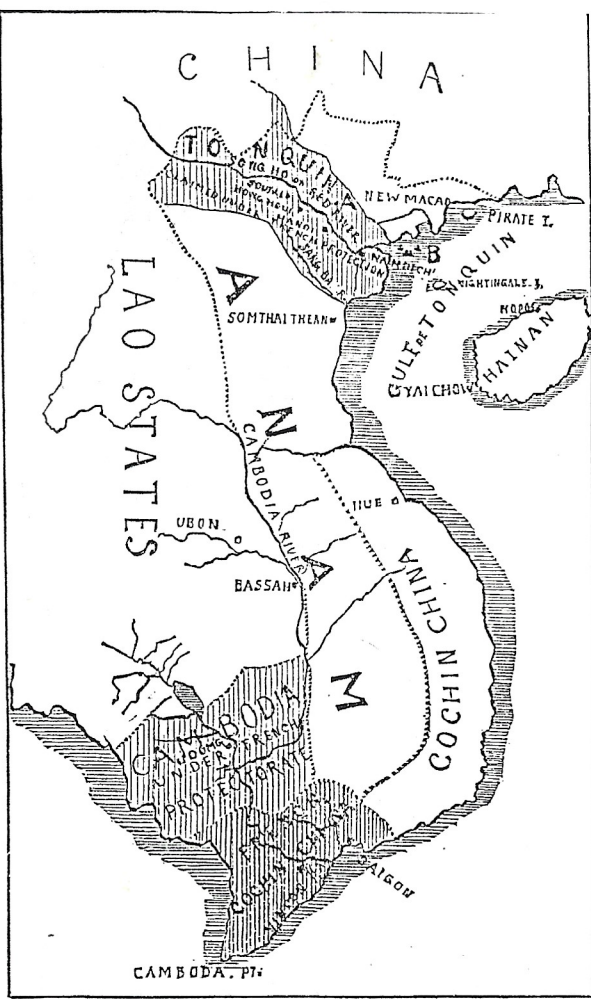

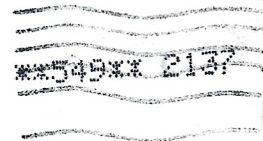
