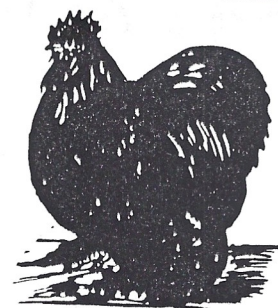

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

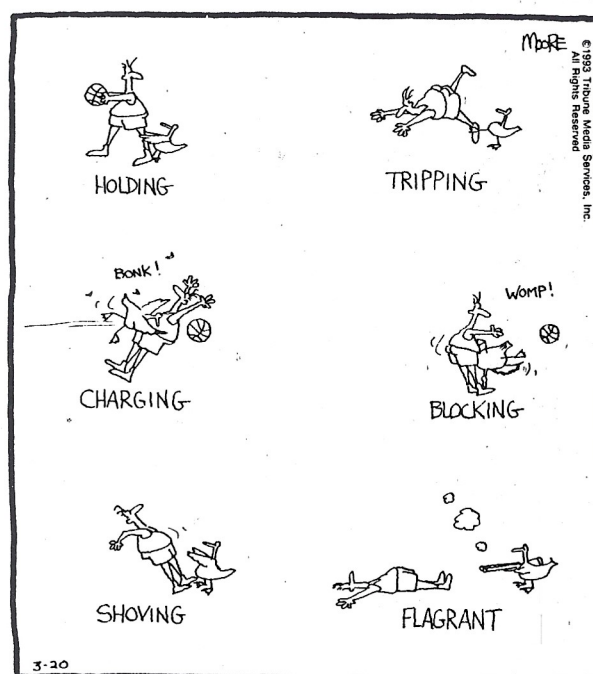

"JUDGING COCHINS FROM MY VIEWPOINT"

FIRST, LET ME SAY WHAT A PLEASURE IT IS WHEN I HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO JUDGE COCHIN NATIONAL MEETS AND I HAVE JUDGED SOME OF THE LARGEST IN THE HISTORY OF THE BREED. IT HAS ALWAYS BEEN A FAVORITE BREED OF MINE TO JUDGE AND NO JUDGE HAS EVER ENJOYED PUTTING A COCHIN ON TOP ANYMORE THAN I HAVE. IT IS A GORGEOUS BIRD WHEN CONDITIONED RIGHT AND IN THE TOP OF CONDITION. OBSERVERS NOT FAMILIAR WITH OUR HOBBY WILL ALWAYS STOP AND TAKE A SECOND LOOK WHEN IN THE COCHIN AISLES.

NOW AS TO WHAT I LOOK FOR IN A GOOD COCHIN. AN APPEARANCE OF GREAT FEATHERING WITH A PROFUSION OF SOFT PLUMAGE. THE BIRD WILL HAVE A ROUND BULKY LOOK, GIVING ONE AN IMPRESSION OF A BIGGER BIRD THAN WHAT IS REALLY THERE. THE TAIL FEATHERS SHOULD GO OVER THE BACK OF THE TAIL RATHER THAN SHOW A CUT OFF APPEARANCE IN THE TAIL AREA.

LOOK FOR THE GOOD ROUND APPEARING BIRD: NARROW BIRDS ARE NOT WHAT ONE WANTS AND WILL GIVE THE LOOK OF BIRDS WITH NOT ENOUGH WIDTH OF FEATHERS AND USUALLY WILL BE TOO LEGGY. THE COMB SHOULD BE FIRM AND SET WITH A LOOK OF LOWER IN THE FRONT THAN IN THE REAR. THE BEAK SHOULD BE SHORT AND CURVED TO A POINT.

THE HEAD SHOULD BE SHORT, FULL, GIVING THE LOOK FROM THE REAR OF BEING ON THE LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE TAIL.. I LOOK FOR A SHORT BACK, FULL AND WELL ROUNDED. WHEN LOOKED AT FROM ABOVE THE BIRD, IT GIVES THE APPEARANCE OF A SHORT, FULL WELL BALANCED BIRD FROM BACK OF THE NECK TO TAIL. THE TOP LINE WILL BE LEVEL, THEN TAKE A GOOD LOOK FROM THE FRONT OF THE BIRD MAKING SURE YOU SEE A FULL FRONT, WELL ROUNDED AND CLOSE TO THE GROUND. YOU SHOULD SEE NO LIGHT UNDER THE BIRD WHEN VIEWING FROM THE FRONT.

I LOOK FOR A FULL TAIL WELL SPREAD AND AN IMPORTANT FEATURE IS THAT YOU HAVE A GREAT AMOUNT OF FEATHERS UNDERNEATH THE TAIL. THE WINGS SHOULD BE WELL CARRIED TO THE SIDES AND HARDLY NOTICEABLE WHEN VIEWING FROM THE SIDES. THE BIRD SHOULD HAVE THAT FORWARD LOOK NEARLY AS IF IT IS LEANING FORWARD.

WHEN LOOKING AT THE BIRD FROM THE FRONT IT IS SO IMPORTANT THAT THE BIRD SHOW THE LEGS SET WELL APART AND STRAIGHT. OF ALL BREEDS THE COCHIN IS ONE THAT NEEDS TO BE IN TIP TOP SHAPE WHEN ENTERED IN THE SHOW ROOM AS THE AMOUNT OF FEATHERS THE BIRD CARRIES IS A MUST TO BE SHOW READY

WHEN JUDGING THE COCHIN, I START FROM THE HEAD MAKING SURE THE BIRD IS NOT CROW-HEADED, THAT IT IS A ROUND WELL FEATHERED BIRD, SHOWING SOME WIDTH OF FEATHER AND A BOLDNESS THAT CATCHES ONE'S ATTENTION. THE REALLY GOOD COCHINS WILL JUMP OUT AT A JUDGE WHEN GOING DOWN THE AISLE. IN JUDGING COCHINS IS THE SMALLER BIRD THE BETTER? I DON'T THINK SO. MANY TIMES IN THE SMALLER COCHIN YOU WILL NOT HAVE THE FEATHERING, THE ROUNDNESS, WIDTH OF FEATHER AND THAT "COCHIN" LOOK WE ARE ALL LOOKING FOR.

I ALWAYS LOOK AT THE BIRD FROM THE FRONT, SIDE VIEW, FROM THE REAR AND CLOSELY FROM THE TOP TO MAKE SURE THE BIRD IS BALANCED IN ALL AREAS THAT MAKES FOR THE WINNING COCHIN. WIDTH OF FEATHER IS REALLY IMPORTANT AND THIS WILL COME OUT IN THE JUDGING PROCESS.

WE AS COCHIN BREEDERS NEED TO CULL HARD AND RAISE LOTS OF BIRDS IN ORDER TO COME UP WITH THAT NEAR-PERFECT BIRD. I HAVE BEEN JUDGING OVER 35 YEARS AND HAVE JUDGED SOME REALLY OUTSTANDING COCHINS IN MY TIME BUT YET TO SEE THE PERFECT BIRD. I HAVE SEEN SOME THAT REALLY CAME CLOSE AND NO JUDGE HAS PUT UP MORE COCHINS FOR CHAMPION OF SHOW THAN I HAVE.

MAKE SURE YOU BREED FOR THE TRUE COCHIN TYPE FIRST THEN INCORPORATE THE OTHER THINGS INTO THE BIRD AND YOU WILL BE ON WINNERS ROW AND WILL BE THERE REGULARLY. NO JUDGE WILL ARGUE WHEN PICKING CHAMPIONS IF YOU HAVE A TOP NOTCH COCHIN UP THERE FOR CONSIDERATION.

SHORT NECK, FULL WELL ROUNDED FRONT GIVING THE APPEARANCE OF LEANING FORWARD. GREAT FULL TAIL WELL SPREAD AND PROFUSION OF FEATHERS UNDERNEATH THE TAIL. IT SHOULD HAVE THE LOOK OF A BALL OR ROUNDNESS WITH A BOLD EYE. YOU HAVE THIS YOU HAVE A WINNER. '

BEST OF LUCK TO ALL OF YOU AND KEEP THE COCHINS IN THE WINNERS CIRCLE.

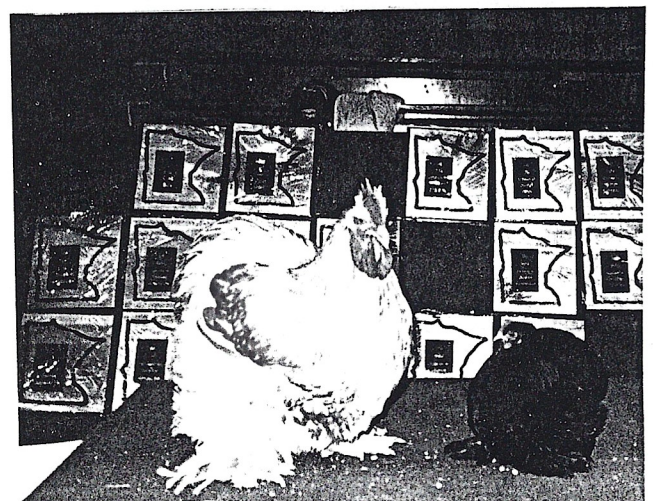

HOW TO RAISE COCHINS ON A SHOESTRING

CATCHY TITLE! THAT IS WHAT YOU HAVE TO LEARN TO DO WHEN YOUR INTO CHICKENS AND YOUR HUSBAND IS INTO GOLF. OH, HE'S PRETTY GOOD ABOUT "CHICKEN SITTING" WHEN I'M AT SHOWS AND HE HELPS THE FRUGAL CHICKEN BREEDER WITH BUILDING JOBS SHE CAN'T HANDLE.

I DECIDED ON COCHINS ABOUT 8 YEARS AGO. I LIKED THEIR DOCILE DISPOSITIONS. I GOT TIRED OF GETTING THE HAMBURGS DOWN OFF THE TV ANTENNA AND THE POLISH OUT OF THE TREES, AS SOON AS THE SUN WENT BEHIND A CLOUD. A COCHIN IS JUST NOT SHAPED TO RUN FAR.

WELL, WHAT DO I MEAN BY A SHOESTRING BUDGET?

1. YOU CAN'T SKIMP ON YOUR STARTER STOCK. GETTING A GOOD BLOOD LINE WITHOUT MAJOR FLAWS IS IMPORTANT!

2. HOUSING. I HAVE MOST OF MY BIRDS INDIVIDUALLY COOPS MADE WITH SCRAP WOOD AND CHICKEN WIRE FOUND AT RUMMAGE SALES. MY SUMMER COOP HAS 2 WALLS OF MINK CAGES. MY HUSBAND TOOK OUT EVERY OTHER PARTITION TO INCREASE EACH INDIVIDUAL SIZE. I PUT MY COCKERELS IN THESE ONCE THEY START TO FIGHT (ONE TROUBLE MAKER AT A TIME). I FIND THE WIRE REALLY DOESN'T DO MUCH DAMAGE TO THE FOOT FEATHERING. MY CAGES WITH FLOORS I FILL WITH WOOD SHAVINGS I GET FREE FROM EVERY WOOD WORKER IN THE AREA. I GET MY FLOOR SHAVINGS FREE FROM A SMALL SAW MILL. MY OUTDOOR RUNS ARE COVERED AND HAVE 3" OF SAND. THATS WHEN THE FOOT FEATHERING GETS WRECKED, WHEN THEY SCRATCH. MY SMALL BARN IS WELL INSULATED AND I USE AN ELECTRIC HEATER AS IT OFTEN GOES DOWN TO 20 BELOW ZERO.

3. BREEDING. I ARTIFICIALLY INSEMINATE ALL MY BIRDS.

4. INCUBATION. I HAVE HAD VERY GOOD LUCK INCUBATING IN THE STYRO FOAM INCUBATORS (HOVABATOR) WITH THE AUTOMATIC TURNER. THE IMPORTANT THING IS A GOOD THERMOMETER (OR 4-THE FRUGAL BREEDER IS ALSO PARANOID). I HATCH SMALL NUMBERS AND EACH PIPING AND HATCH TIME IS RECORDED. I MONITOR DEVELOPMENT WITH THE COOL-LITE CANDLER. WHEN I SEE THE CHICK UP IN THE AIR SAC I PUT A PIN HOLE IN THE EGG. THEN THEY CAN TAKE THEIR TIME IN HATCHING AND CAN BREATHE. I NEVER BREED TO A BIRD THAT HASN'T HATCHED ON TIME OR A DAY EARLY. I BAND MY CHICKS USING COLORED TWISTER TIES (FOUND IN BAGGIES PRODUCTS). I CUT THEM IN HALF, THEN SHAPE THEM AROUND A PENCIL. THEIR HATCHING NUMBER IS THEN WRITTEN ON THE INSIDE. IF THEIR OUTSIDE TOES SEEM TO WANT TO TURN UNDER I TAKE MASKING TAPE AND PUT A PIECE ON THE TOP AND BOTTOM OF THE FOOT MAKING THE TOES GO FLAT. LEAVE ON 2 OR 3 DAYS AND THE

TOES WILL BE PERFECT.

5. BROODING. MY BROODER IS TWO CARD BOARD BOXES DUCT TAPED TOGETHER WITH A GLASS WINDOW IN ONE SIDE. THE FLOOR IS COVERED WITH OLD BATH TOWELS (HELPS KEEP THE TOES STRAIGHT). I HANG 2 METAL LIGHT DOMES WITH 60 WATT YELLOW LIGHT BULBS FOR WARMTH. (CLEAR BULBS CAN CAUSE BLINDNESS). DON'T FORGET THE DROWN PROOF WATER CONTAINERS. AFTER ONE WEEK I MOVE THEM TO THE BIG BROODER A BOX 6 x 6 MADE AGAIN WITH LARGE CARD BOARD BOXES (TISSUE, PAPER TOWEL ETC) FROM THE GROCERY STORE AND DUCT TAPE. I COULDN'T RAISE CHICKENS WITH OUT DUCT TAPE. THE FLOOR IS COVERED WITH WOOD SHAVINGS AND AGAIN I HANG TWO YELLOW LIGHT BULBS. I COVER PART OF THE BOX WITH A SCREEN TO CUT DOWN ON THE DUST AS I RAISE MY YOUNG BIRDS IN THE BASEMENT TILL THE MIDDLE OF MAY.

6. CHICK FEED. I FEED MEDICATED CHICK STARTER (PURINA) AND LOTS OF HARD BOILED EGG AND ALTERNATE FRESH WATER WITH WATER WITH VITAMINS AND ELECTROLYTES. AS THEIR WING FEATHERS GROW TO ABOUT 2" I CUT THEM OFF AS THIS HELPS THEM TO TUCK THEIR WINGS UP HIGHER.

7. ADULT FEED. ALL MY BIRDS GET OUTSIDE WEATHER PERMITTING, ON A ROTATION BASIS. I HAVE 2 x 8 MOVEABLE RUNWAYS COVERED WITH CHICKEN WIRE (WE HAVE LOTS OF HAWKS) SO THEY CAN GET ON GRASS. MAY THROUGH OCTOBER I FEED EVERYONE MED. CHICK STARTER, WITH THE ADULTS GETTING SOME CRACKED CORN AND SUNFLOWER SEEDS FOR FUN. MY WINTER FEED IS A SPECIAL BLEND MASH WITH EVERYTHING A BREEDING CHICKEN NEEDS. EVEN HAS VITAMINS AND ELECTROLYTES GROUND IN. I MAKE A WARM MASH EACH MORNING WITH THE MIX, WARM WATER, BUTTERMILK, AND COOKED PEAS. I USE THE SODA BOTTLE WATERERS AND EVERYONE SAVES PLACTIC ONES FOR ME AND I REPLACE THEM OFTEN.

THERE! RAISING CHICKENS WITHOUT ALOT OF COST. OH! I ALMOST FORGOT. CARRYING BOXES FOR CHICKEN SHOWS. BANANA BOXES WITH SCREEN DUCT TAPED TO THE TOP. THEY HAVE LOTS OF HOLES FOR GOOD VENTILATION.

SOME OF MY IDEAS ARE ORIGINAL BUT MANY WERE GIVEN TO ME BY MY BREEDER FRIENDS JAN BOLTON, KEITH LEGRAND, AND BILL KRUEGER. BE SURE TO HELP SOMEONE STARTING OUT.

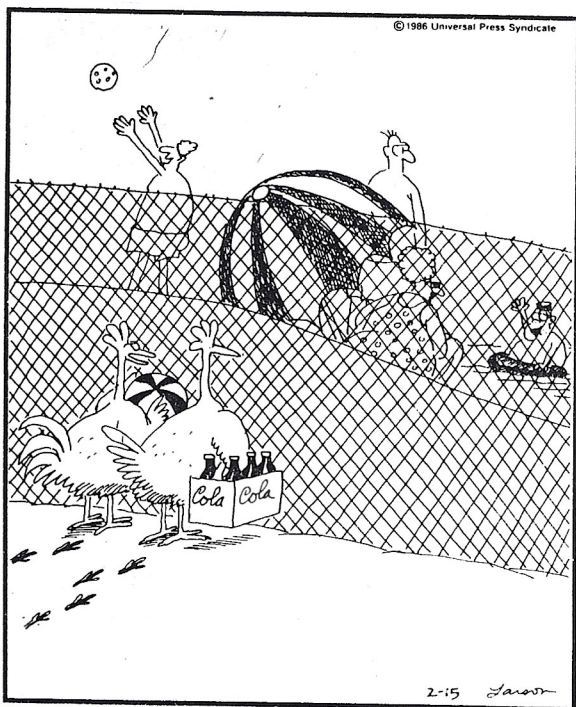

HISTORY OF COCHINS

SEVERAL PEOPLE RESPONDED WITH INFORMATION ON THE ORIGIN OF "COCHINS".

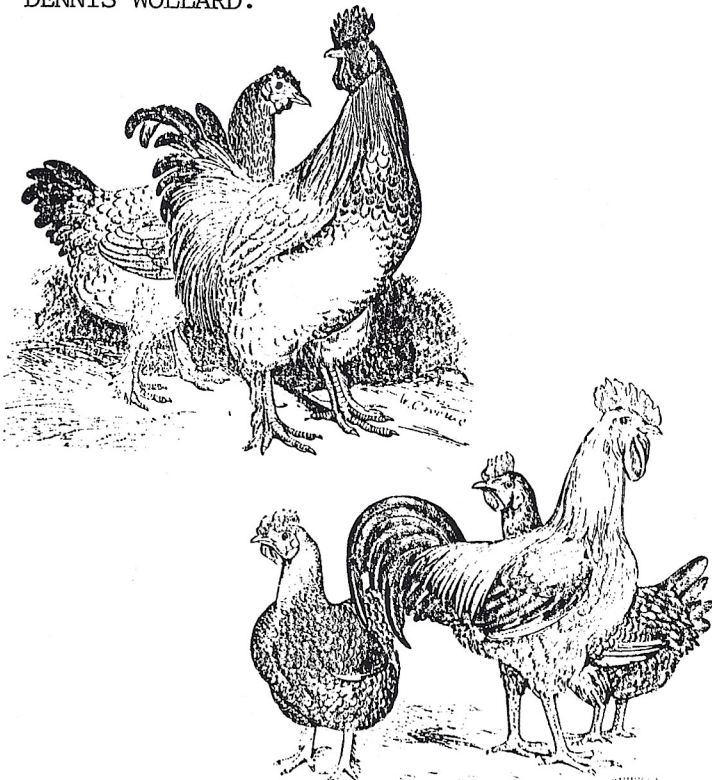
IN 1843 QUEEN VICTORIA OF ENGLAND WAS PRESENTED EIGHT BIRDS FROM CHINA AS A GIFT FROM THE BRITISH AMBASSADOR. THESE FOWL WERE FIRST KNOWN AS "SHANGHAI", THEN COCHIN CHINA, AND LATER AS COCHIN. THE QUEEN WAS VERY INTERESTED IN POULTRY, AND WAS THE FIRST TO EXHIBIT "COCHINS" IT WAS FIRST THOUGHT ALL VARIETIES OF COCHINS DECEDED FROM THESE HOWEVER, MANY SHIPMENTS OF COCHINS WERE SENT FROM CHINA TO ENGLAND AND AMERICA DURING THE SPAN OF 1840 - 1850.

THE COCHIN OF THAT TIME HAS LITTLE RESEMBLANCE TO THE COCHIN OF TODAY! MANY OF THEM HAD NO FEATHERS ON THEIR SHANKS. SOME WERE FAIRLY WELL FEATHERED. ALL HAD SINGLE COMBS. THEIR FLESH WAS CLAIMED TO BE SUPERIOR IN TASTE TO ANY OTHER FOWL. THE PUBLIC WAS INFATUATED WITH THE "SHANGHAI" FAD AND RESTURANTS COMPLIED FILLING THE DEMAND. (SEE MENU)

GEORGE BURNHAM WAS THE FIRST TO HAVE "COCHINS" IN AMERICA IN 1848. HE LATER SENT A TRIO TO QUEEN VICTORIA AS A GIFT. SHE IN RETURN SENT HIM AN OIL PAINTING OF HERSELF.

THE FIRST MINATURE COCHINS WERE OBTAINED FROM CHINA AT THE SACKING OF THE SUMMER PALACE AT PEKIN IN 1860. APPARENTLY NO "PEKINS" OTHER THAN BUFF AND BLACK WERE EVER IMPORTED FROM CHINA AND ALL OTHER COLOR VARIETIES HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED IN THE WEST.
