White and Buff Feather Quality (or lack there of...)

For those cochin breeders who have bred either white or buff cochin bantams, a feather phenomenon quite often occurs with the first adult moult. While the juvenile feathers in the tail area seem fine.... the development of the tail feathers in subsequent moults is less than desirable. It appears that the mechanism that allows the feather webbing to expand just doesn't do it's job and each tail feather, especially over the top of the tail appears "stringy". I have experienced this unfortunate occurrence in birds that have white or buff tails, but for some reason, it does not seem to affect blacks and blues. I have had considerable discussion regarding this point with both Pat Lacey and Bob Hawes. Bob contends that it is genetic, which makes sense, however, my best buff hen was fine as a pullet.... terrible as a yearling... and has moulted out correctly as a 2 year old. This puzzles me. Pat has talked to various people on the subject and one source indicated it might have something to do with the moisture content of the feathers during the developmental stage. I have had quite a few notes/comments from breeders both old and new suggesting that this is not an isolated situation.

Any comments/solutions from any of you veterans would be welcome information for many!! KR

I have had a continuing correspondence with the vice president of the APA concerning the problems that occurred last January at the Springfield show. BArt has been very helpful in attempting to clarify the problem. To date we are at this point... there seems to be no documentation on file at the APA on this issue of unlicensed judges. When the APA changed their policy they did not open it to the membership for a referendum, they voted among the directors.

This is what I have done and suggest that any of you who feel as strongly about this issue as I do, is to send a facsimile of my simple letter to the APA so that you can go on record as being opposed to the use of unlicensed judges at any APA sanctioned meet. The APA must represent it's membership. I have also included a copy of a letter from my good friend Paul Ashbrook, which goes into greater detail.
