Cochins International NE1 District News by Donna Lamb :

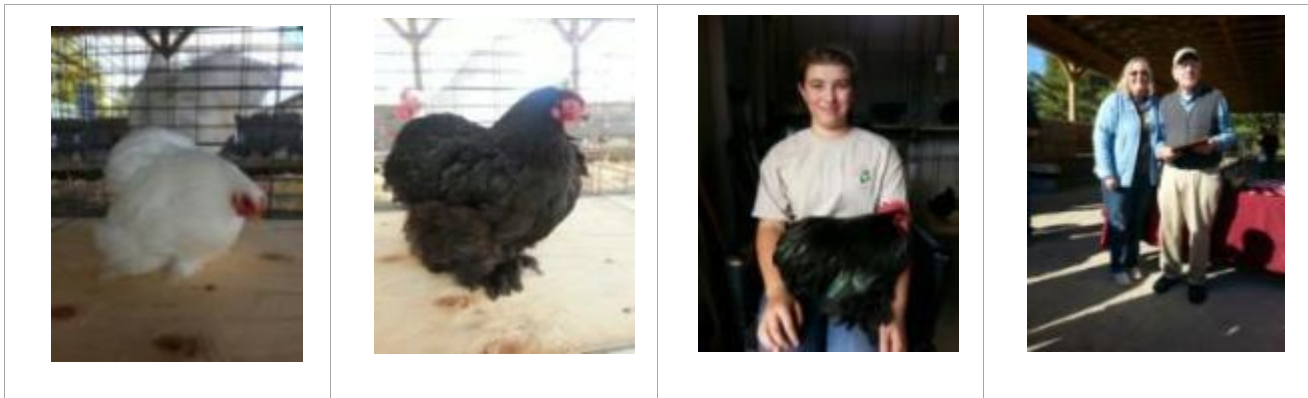

NE II Directors Report by Rich Barczewski

I hope that you and your families have had a wonderful Holiday Season and I wish you all a prosperous and healthy New Year.

Greetings from the North East II District of Cochins International. Thanks to everyone who voted in our last election. Now is the time to pull back together and to work for the betterment of our breed. I had several opportunities to travel to shows this fall and made it to Lebanon Valley in Pennsylvania to help support them in their first show. The show was wonderful and well planned for a first show and included a couple of special events that set it apart from many shows in our District. I think this is one show you might want to consider attending in the future. I also had a chance to attend the Ohio National in Columbus for the first time since 2002. This show had a great turnout of cochins in both bantam

and large fowl and you have probably already heard that it served as the qualifying meet for the splash variety. It was also the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the ABA. I also had a chance to attend the APA National Meet which was held in Knoxville, TN. This was another great show with a lot of Cochins shown.

There has been a lot of chatter on the Cochin pages of Facebook regarding “new varieties” and as someone who works with a less popular accepted variety, I think we need to proceed with caution with getting new varieties accepted to the standard. I say this because too many newly accepted varieties of birds disappear from the show halls soon after they are accepted into the standard. As an example, when was the last time you saw a white crested cuckoo polish bantam? They were accepted in 2002 in Columbus and have become almost non-existent. We can make cochins in just about any color with a little time and dedication but the bigger question is why we are making these new varieties.

I’m not against new varieties and some actually make a lot of sense. The splash was a good example of this. It was a variety that was already prevalent in the show halls and was routinely being produced.

When someone decides that they want to establish a new variety, they need to do several things. They need to work hard in their breeding pens first and then they need to get those birds out and seen in the show halls. Producing a new variety is not about one person raising the variety but rather about having a group of individuals committed to that variety. Those individuals should have a strong enough commitment to the variety to do all the groundwork to get the variety out there and promoted, but also have a commitment to keeping that variety for years and perhaps even decades after it is approved. Continuing to show and promote it.

It is a lifetime commitment and one that takes a special individual to make happen. In most cases, it is expensive, difficult and requires several individuals willing to work together to see it through. Make sure you think this through before you start this project.

Until next time, I wish you much success in your breeding pens and in the show halls this coming year. As always, Rich

Greetings! I hope everyone is enjoying the holiday season. I’m pleased to have this opportunity to share some news with you and dive right into my new role as Director for Canada.

The 2014 Eastern National was held in Fergus, Ontario on September 27. All the Cochin exhibitors at this meet were from Canada. I expect this was largely due to the complexities and expenses of crossing the border with birds.

On November 22 & 23, the APA Canadian National was held in Red Deer, Alberta. This was designated as a CI Special Meet. The weather can make or break an Alberta show at that time of year, so it was a relief when the forecast came

through with above-freezing temperatures throughout the weekend. There was, however some freezing rain to the north which made travel dicey for exhibitors coming from that direction.

There were over 800 poultry entries, making this the largest poultry show that's been held in Red Deer to date. I've been told this year's event now holds the record of being the biggest show in Alberta's history! The organizing club, Canadian Heritage Breeds did a remarkable job putting on the show and included extra activities and attractions to make it enjoyable for families. There was substantial prize money up for grabs and a good number of Junior exhibitors taking part.

In the Bantam class, varieties included Black and Frizzle, with a total of 6 Bantam Cochins. BV, BB and Reserve Class went to a Black K by C-R Ducks. Reserve Breed was also a Black K by C-R Ducks.

There were 20 Large Fowl Cochins exhibited in the open show including Black, Blue, Partridge, Buff and Silver Laced. BV, BB and Class Champion went to a Blue K by Kathy Stevenson. RV, RB and Reserve Class Champion was a Blue P by Kathy Stevenson. It was great to see such an assortment of colors being exhibited, including some of those less-common varieties.

With the fall shows now over I'm ready to start setting up breeding pens. The anticipation of those first chicks of the season is guaranteed to drive away the winter blues! Here's wishing you all great success in 2015!

### **Special Meet – Master Breeder Program:**

We have a well-established Master Breeder Program, whereby members earn points based on the number of Cochins exhibited at shows which host Cochins International meets. There are currently two Master Breeder point total recognition levels. Upon achieving 100 points in any given variety a Cochin Breeder receives a Certificate of Achievement. Master Breeder status is earned upon reaching 500 points in a variety and a plaque is awarded to recognize this achievement.

Points are accumulated as follows:

- Master Breeder upon achieving 500 points in no less than five (5) years.
- One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Best and Reserve of Variety.
- One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Best and Reserve of Breed.
- One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Overall Champion (FL and Bantams).
- There must be at least five Large Fowl and five Bantam Cochins in competition.
- The points are awarded for the highest win an individual bird earns in its class.

A Certificate of Merit will be awarded for the first One Hundred points in any variety.

Master Breeder status is earned upon reaching 500 points in a variety and a plaque is award to recognize this achievement.
