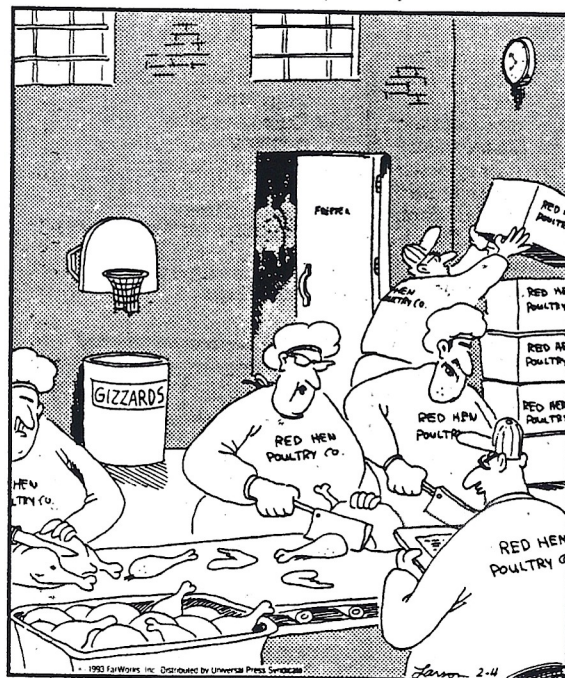
We offer the following inducements for your 1996 Eastern National Meet:

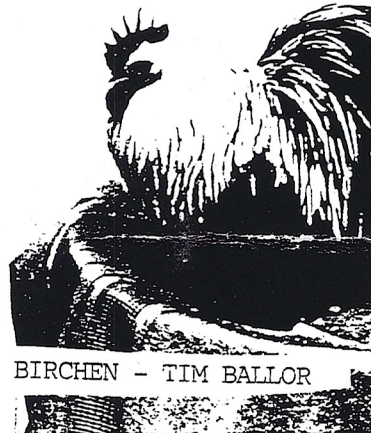

LETTER FROM THOMAS ROEBUCK..NORTHEAST DIST.

I AM WRITING IN REGARDS TO SPLITTING THE NORTHEAST DISTRICT INTO TWO SMALLER DISTRICTS I THINK IT WOULD BE A GOOD THING AND THE RIGHT THING TO DO. IT'S NOT THE SQUARE MILES THAT ARE A PROBLEM, BUT INSTEAD THE LONGITUDINAL MILES. I THINK ONE DISTRICT SHOULD INCLUDE MAINE, NEW HAMPSHIRE, VERMONT, MASSACHUSETTS, RHODE ISLAND, CONNECTICUT, AND NEW YORK. WITH THE SECOND DISTRICT TO BE COMPRISED OF PENNSYLVANIA, NEW JERSEY, DELAWARE, MARYLAND, WEST VIRGINIA, AND VIRGINIA. IN MY OPINION THIS WAY OF DIVIDING THE STATES MAKES MORE SENSE.

SOME GOOD EXAMPLES OF DISTANCE ARE THE 922 MILES BETWEEN BANGOR, ME AND RICHMOND, VA OR THE 446 MILES FROM BANGOR TO NEW YORK CITY, AND THE 697 MILES FROM BANGOR TO

BUFFALO. THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE EXISTING DISTRICT FOR EXAMPLE IS PHILADELPHIA TO NORFOLK AT 272 MILES OR PITTSBURG TO NORFOLK AT 438 MILES AND NEWARK TO CHARLESTON WV AT 472 MILES.

SO YOU SEE, IT DOES MAKE MORE SENSE TO DIVIDE INTO 2 DISTRICTS WITH SEPARATE DIRECTORS. I ALSO THINK PEOPLE THESE DAYS, WITH THE COST OF GAS, OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS, AND MEALS AREN'T LIKELY TO TRAVEL THESE DISTANCES FROM NORTH TO SOUTH OR VISE VERSA FOR A DISTRICT MEET.

I ALSO WOULD LIKE TO LOCATE AND HEAR FROM ANYONE RAISING COLOMBIAN COCHINS. I THINK IT WOULD BE A SHAME IF THIS VARIETY OF COCHINS DIE OUT. MAYBE WE COULD SET UP A NETWORK OF BREEDERS TO IMPROVE THIS VARIETY.

The distinguishing characteristic of a flock in normal health is enthusiasm. A hen sings before she lays and cackles afterward. The rest of the time she scratches, digs or dusts with evident enjoyment. She needs no rouge on her face. Her eye sparkles. No sing; no lay and no cackle, and I might add, no profit.

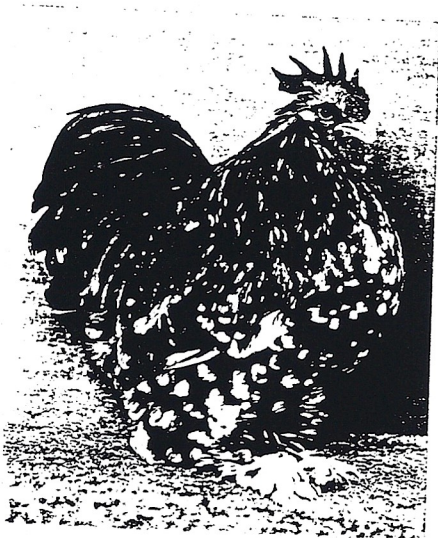
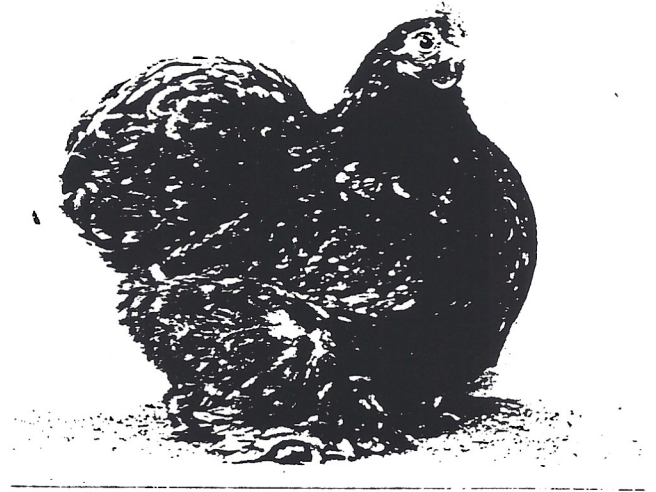
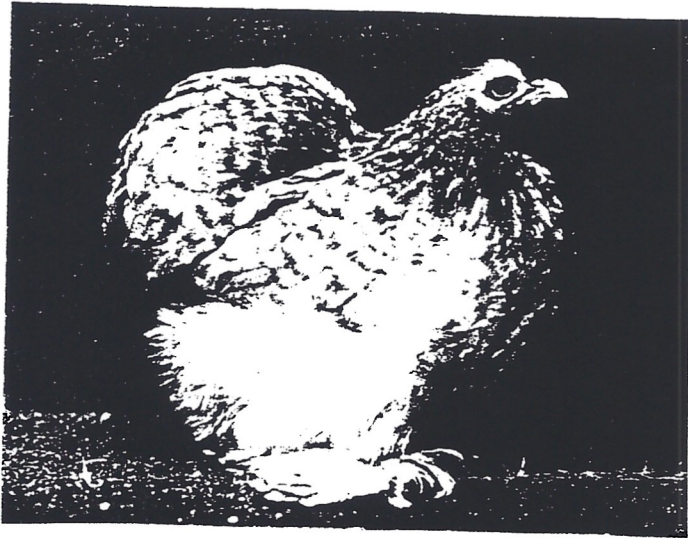
A good rooster cannot keep his triumphant clarion corked up long enough to get a full night's sleep. He is not very popular in congested districts. He is too enthusiastic about himself and his affairs. This trait is inexcusable in a man, but in a rooster it is the infallible accompaniment of well-being. If he does not crow he will soon croak.

Watch the spirit of your flock. The minute enthusiasm lags, look for the cause. You will find something out of line. Maybe the water dish is sour. Maybe the last sack of mash is a little stale. Maybe the grit or oyster shell has run out. Maybe they hanker for a bit of meat, or charcoal or green salad. It is you, Mr. Caretaker, who must discover what it is, and when you do and remedy the matter, see with what enthusiasm the item that has been overlooked is now appreciated.

If your birds are glad and expectant every time you come into the yard, it is a good sign. If they are drowsy and dumpy, and seem indifferent when feeding time comes, look out! This is the beginning of sorrow. Better check up on the boss. His habits need mending. The poor birds, being in captivity, are like clay in a potter's hands. Give them a fair chance and they will be happy, spreading good cheer all over the place.

Don't build a Queen Ann house for your birds and expect them to lay three eggs a day apiece to pay for it.

Don't fill them full of all the patent medicine you can hear of to see whether it will kill them or not. Try common horse sense awhile and see how much better you get along.

Give them good warm houses to stay in, feed corn and lots of it.

Tell the man who says "corn is no good" that I said I knew better. I have tried those things long enough to know.

Get you a first-class bone cutter and feed green bone three times a week in the winter time and corn twice a day with ground corn mixed with hot water for their breakfast and you will get eggs.

Watch your hens and if one only lays every three or four days, kill her and give her to the poor for she will make you *poor* if you keep her. Set eggs from your best layers and see what improvements you will be able to make in a few years.
