THE IDEAL COCHIN?

Should the Cochin breeders want to know what an "Ideal" Cochin looks like?


We all have a good general idea, but no one seems to agree on details. This is also apparently true with the judges.

A recent observation indicates to me that the judges need help, as we do, defining and selecting a good cochin. Recently at two shows, and one week apart, a black was best Cochin and reserve featherleg at the first show and placed fifth in her class the following week. The class of blacks was almost identical with only a few additions that did not alter the results. The best black at the second show placed third in his class at the first show!

It's possible, I suppose, a person could say that the class of blacks was so good that any one of the birds could win, or that it was so bad it was hard to pick a good one.

Both judges were "licensed" and I suppose the loser would say the judges "were no good", one could have been good and one could have been bad, one could have had a bad day or both could have bad days, or any other excuse one wants to make. I am convinced that we as breeders do not know or can agree on the details of an "Ideal Cochin", so if that is true how can we expect a judge to know?

A breeder said to me not long ago..." talk to the judge after the judging has been completed and find out what he's looking for, then next time you should win". I've heard others say "this guy likes them small" or "this guy likes them big and if you don't know bring one of each". Is it our objective to win at any cost by out writing the judge? It would appear that the legitimate breeder

is trying to produce a perfect bird thereby winning in competition to prove it. If the above is the purpose of the majority then the perfect cochin has to be defined so that both breeder and judges can speak the same language.

In examining the ABA standard, I see no reference to any cochin club offering assistance with the standard. It is my belief that the specialty club should be the developer of the "ideal". I would propose a committee of three reputable twenty year veteran breeders and exhibitors get together with a competent artist and draw a full size three dimensional model showing measurement that should be the "ideal" for today. To do this would eliminate from our written description the words...small, large stout, swarthy, short, long, etc....words that absolutely have no meaning.

HELP needed.....

This week I have received two articles for the newsletter relative to our standard and judging. Maybe just a coincidence... but... do we need to look at anything. My father's article revolves around two topics...weight size...and judging inconsistency. I can identify with both...as my father and I have talked at great length about these two topics. Sour grapes doesn't enter into it at all, I, too, have seen gross inconsistencies. I showed a black hen who placed 6th out of 6 hens at a show (and I might add using the judge's checkmark system earned only one check... the other five got at least 2 checks with the winner getting four.), the following week, she was not only the class winner but best cochin in the show. For those who immediately 'scream' ...well how about feather quality and condition... I can vouch for the fact that she was no different in both shows. It was strictly a different judges interpretation on a different day. Interestingly enough, Bob Hawes, a licensed judge, suggested the hen in the first show WAS indeed the best cochin in the show not 6th! It is not my intent to beat up on judges. I suspect in any given show ...even the veteran entrants would be hard pressed to all pick the same "best cochin". So what is the problem. I suspect...interpretation of a vague standard. I believe this is the

point my father is trying to make. Is it time to take a hard look at the standard... only the specialty club(s) involved can decide! We are that club... COCHINS INTERNATIONAL! The second issue is the issue of size or weight in our bantams. Here is an area where I disagree somewhat with dear ole Dad. Size perception I believe is the key. To weigh all specimens is unworkable....I do believe many cochin bantams are grossly overweight (when you get a chance weigh YOUR birds...I think you will be surprised). So in my view we as breeders have the responsibility to work to keep at least the "appearance" of our birds "small"they are bantams!

Are OUR COCHIN BANTAMS too big???.

The other day I had a very nice phone conversation with Brian Justice. We, of coarse, talked "cochins" at great length. However, the reason Brian called was for clarification regarding Master Points and membership "names". Question: If Brian joins CI as a family are all his family members entitled to master points individually? As we evolve as a club issues such as these must be answered. The worst thing that can happen to a club is to have different rules for different people. I have been guilty of this regarding master points. For example, I know Mark and Larry Peterson are a team...however, in the past sometimes they would enter individually... I did give the team of Larry & Mark Peterson the points each received. I am not sure this is right and I know it creates a lot of extra work for yours truly! I might add Larry & Mark have since consolidated their "name", which I greatly appreciated. What would happen if we had 1000 members and 700 of them were listed as partners, husband and wife or families. The work involved would be overwhelming. Since my conversation with Brian, I have been in contact with

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In the current standard there is one requirement that we should all be able to agree upon and that is weight. However, if the judge adhered to the weight requirements there would probably be no birds in the show ...or at the very least most would be disqualified.

The weight standard for bantams is 30 oz. cock, 26 oz. hen, 26 oz. cockeral, 24 oz. pullet. Disqualification is 4 oz. over 30 oz. ? At one show a judge placed a cochin of superior type 2nd because it was too big and wouldn't easily fit through the show pen door! If the bird was truly over the 4 oz. allowance, it should have been disqualified and I do not believe any judge should disqualify a bird for weight (i.e. size) without the use of scales. I believe the standard for weight should be 26 oz. through 34 oz. all ages and both sexes. Scales should be made available to judges.

Some of the articles in the booklet, "Cochin Bantams" refers to an "ideal". If an "ideal" does exist should"t it be made available? (Ideal=Picture?)

The following sketches are to show how, I believe, one way that an "ideal" Cochin can be visualized. Then perhaps a written description can be used to supplement the drawings.

(Unfortunately, due to space limitations I didn't have space for sketches. Sorry Dad!)

both Tim and Pat. They were in agreement that based on the work involved. The following clarification is necessary. Master points will be awarded to each member as it appears on the secretaries record. The following examples should answer any questions.

1. Member name: Bill & Mary Smith

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Entries at shows should be Bill&Mary Smith or B&M Smith. Entries under the name of Bill Smith would not receive points under the membership of Bill & Mary Smith. Nor would Mary Smith. Of coarse, Mary Smith could receive points individually but only if she paid separate dues. There could be two or even three different memberships in this case, each earning Master Points. Membership name: The Jones Family

For a family to receive points, entries at shows must be listed as Jones Family. If Bob Jones enters birds under his name, points will not be awarded. If Bob, wife Pat and son Gerry all want to earn points and be listed separately, then they must all pay individual dues. Although I am relatively new to this club, I do not think a "family membership" was intended to be tied into the concept of master points.

Membership name: Johnny's Bantams Similar to the family name above. Entries should be made as Johnny's Bantams. If show entries are received as John Jones, they will not be recorded under Johnny's Bantams.

I hope this clarifies the awarding of points. Some of you will be directly impacted by these "rules". All points already awarded will be grandfathered. If any of you feel slighted or are angered by these decisions...please consider the amount of work that goes into the newsletter by ye ole editor and the amount of additional work that otherwise would be required.

Elsewhere in this newsletter you will see a list of the current membership as of 10/1/96. Points, from this point on, will be awarded based on the NAMES printed in this list. IF you would like your "points" name different from that which is listed, please send the change to me ASAP. (Karl Rau RR2 Box 3350 South China, Maine 04358).

CLEAVAGE WHO NEEDS IT?

"Balance", that's the one word to describe a good cochin. This means that the legs are mid-way of the body. With legs too far back we produce the "guinea-hen" posture, something we often see in the less popular varieties. Legs too far forward result in low breasts and high tails. Stick a handle in the vent and you have a self-propelled dust-mop.

Study the bird on page one of the November Poultry Press. This cockerel by Tim Hooker looks close to ideal to me.

But, and here's my problem, balance mans a full and prominent breast to counter-balance the full and broad tail. Now the "standard" states that the breast should be carried well forward, extremely full, well rounded, of great breadth and depth. Both the ABA and the APA descriptions are worded similarly.

If you are fortunate enough to posses a prominent, full, rounded, broad, and deep breast you would like it to be smooth, undivided, without cleft, without split, and no cleavage here, please.

Having kept several varieties of cochin bantams over many years I've seen most of the body styles: short, tall, squat, leggy, narrow, pinched, shallow breasted, etc. So when I find that well-balanced, full-breasted bird, I'm excited. Well, as excited as Mainers can get. But when you also find a deep cleft in an otherwise perfect breast, it does cause one to resort to low-level profanity. The problem is that the better specimens seem to exhibit cleavage and it is often not evident until after washing.

Case in point, this past summer I watched two buff pullets developing pretty good type, pretty good color, full fronts, no cleavage. They were from two different "non-cleavage" matings, not even half sibs. They were bathed for the New Hampshire show and within 24 hours-cleavage!

Most exhibitors, including myself, do not care for split breasts, and I notice that buffs are not alone in showing this defect. Some other breeds also show the problem but on these breeds the shape and size of the breast is of less importance than in the cochin.

The obvious advice is to cull all birds with this defect. Easier said than done in small flocks. Should we ask the ABA/APA to list split breasts as a defect? Probably if your variety shows it you'd be inclined to say no. If it is not listed as a defect, should a judge give it consideration? He/she isn't obligated to do so. Is it worth worrying about? Who needs it? Opinions appreciated?

The 1996 Nationals were a great success. The Wisconsin International in Sept.(E) and the APA National at Hutchinson, MN (W) each had over 100 bantams entered and each had large entries of large cochins. Terry Britt judged Wisconsin, and John Thomforde at MN. The Wisconsin show provided a cochin champion row that was very impressive. Competition was tough! I don't know how sportsmanship is in your cochin aisles, but we have a lot of fun. We let the birds compete, not the exhibitors.

Elections have been recorded. Please support your local district directors and your club officials, who give of <u>their free time</u> to operate <u>your club</u>. Don't forget Karl and the Newsletter. Karl does a fine job but he needs your help with photos, articles, cartoons, stories, chicken information that you may have to send him. Input from the membership is what makes the newsletter interesting.

The district directors voted unanimously on a constitutional change. It reads as follows.... A member will be allowed to buy back master points if a membership has lapsed for 1 year. You must make payment for the current year and the year that has lapsed. This would allow the reinstatement of the master points up to the year of the lapse. Only a 1 year buy back would be allowed. Since many of us in our lives can experience a year of confusion due to a loss of job, having to move, care for a sick child, parent, spouse, go through a divorce, we felt this was creating a kinder, gentler club.

Still have not received the APA paintings for male and female brown red and birchen bantam cochin. When we do we will have pictures of them in the newsletter for those interested in bidding on them.

also our trophy chairman. He is the one that will order and mail out our trophies for our national and District meets. We will try our best to shorten the time between the show that you won at and the time that you receive the trophy. Most show secretaries take up to 6 mo. in filing the show report. When Karl receives the show report, he forwards a copy to Tim and Tim orders the trophies. The making of the trophies may take another month. You can be looking at 6-8 months before you receive your award. Please understand why it takes so long! We also decided to use Castlebury Plaques for the Master Breeer Points award. These plaques will have a raised relief cochin on the plaque. They are very impressive. Just a reminder to send your notarized letter to the APA if you are not in favor of shows using unlicensed judges. 
FROM ; BERNICE MACLAREN
