
AC COME OF VOIT MAY HAVE HEARD BY NOW, ETMON



MY DAD RUSSELL, HANDLED THE BREEDING PROGRAM WHEN MY BROTHERS AND I WERE YOUNG. HE DID NOT TALK TOO MUCH TO US ABOUT HOW HE MATED DIFFERENT COLORS OR WHY HE PUT ONE BIRD WITH ANOTHER.

green characteristics

I REMEMBER HOW WE HAD FIVE PENS OF BLACK, FOUR PENS OF BUFF, THREE PENS OF PARTRIDGE, THREE PENS OF SILVER LACED AND THREE PENS OF GOLDEN LACED. ALL IN STANDARDS. WE HAD ALOT OF BREEDING PENS WITH AT LEAST ONE MALE AND TWO FEMALES. SOMETIMES THERE WERE MORE FEMALES IF MY DAD THOUGHT THE MALE COULD HANDLE THEM. I REMEMBER THE EXACT NUMBER OF PENS BECAUSE I HAD TO CLEAN THEM. THE SAME NUMBER OF PENS IN THE SAME COLORS APPLIED TO THE BANTAMS, EXCEPT FOR THE BUFFS. THERE WERE AT LEAST SEVEN BUFF PENS SOMETIMES NINE. WE NEEDED MORE BUFF BANTAM PENS BECAUSE OF THE DIFFERENCE IN SHADING, RANGING FROM LIGHT YELLOW TO RICH YELLOW ALMOST RED.

THE STANDARD BUFF CARRIED AN EVEN COLOR THROUGHOUT EXCEPT FOR SOME BLACK SPECKS SHOWING UP IN THE TAILS. WE DID NOT WORRY ABOUT THE BLACK AS MUCH AS HOW MUCH WHITE SHOWED IN THE WINGS. WE DID NOT USE BIRDS SHOWING WHITE FOR BREEDING. WE ATE THEM! MY DAD DID NOT BELIEVE IN TAKING BIRDS TO THE AUCTION. HE DAID THE BUYER COULD GET A GOOD START IN BREEDING FOR ALMOST NO EXPENSE.

THE BANTAM BUFF SEEMED TO HAVE TOO MANY SHADES OF BUFF TO BALANCE TO COLOR TO SHOW A BRILLIANCE FOR THIS REASON, WE USED MORE BREEDING PENS.

THE BLACKS WERE PRETTY EVEN IN FAULTS TO BREED. ONLY USING BIRDS WITH GOOD HEADS AND HAVING WIDTH OF FEATHER DID WE START OUR PENS. WE TRIED TO STAY AWAY FROM PURPLE IN ITS GREEN SHEEN. IF WE HAD TO USE ONE FOR FERTILITY, IT WAS RARE.

PARTRIDGE WERE MORE OF A CHALLENGE TO BREED. WE MANAGED TO GET GOOD COLOR IN THE FEMALES SO THE PROBLEM TO WORK ON WAS THE RED IN THE BREAST OF THE MALES. WATCHING WHAT COLOR THE FEMALE HACKLE WAS IN THE PENS, THE MALE COLOR IMPROVED. THE DARKER SHADE THE HACKLE THE BETTER.

SILVER AND GOLDEN LACED WERE TWO MORE COLORS WE TOYED WITH. TYPE WAS NOT EASY TO OBTAIN. WE FOLLOWED EVEN COLORED BREEDING AND TRIED TO BREED OUT STIFF TAILS AND HOCKS.

ABOUT THE YEAR 1977 OUT OF A PARTRIDGE MATING, A BROWN COLORED HEN WITH A LIGHT HACKLE COLOR WAS

PRODUCED. WE TRIED TO MAKE A BROWN MALE, BUT GENES WERE TOO CLOSE TO THE PARTRIDGE MALE. DURING THE NEXT TWO YEARS THE FEMALES COLOR IMPROVED BUT THE MALE COLOR WOULD NOT DARKEN. ALOT OF THE PARTRIDGE MALES STARTED TO BE A LIGHTER COLOR, NOT CHESTNUT AND THIS SEEMED TO CAUSE A PROBLEM MAKING AN IDEAL BROWN COLOR.

UNFORTUNATELY OUR DAD PASSED AWAY IN 1979. AT THAT TIME ONLY TWO OF HIS SONS RAISED COCHINS. NOW IN 1993 ONLY ONE DOES, ME.

I NEVER REALLY TALKED TO MY DAD ABOUT HIS BREEDING PROGRAM. I HAD TO START ON MY OWN WITH GOOD QUALITY STOCK BEHIND ME. THROUGHOUT THE YEARS I TALKED ABOUT GENETICS WITH THE LATE HAROLD GEESAMAN, AN ARTIST FROM PALMYRA, PA. NOW I HAVE BEEN BREEDING COCHINS FOR MANY YEARS AND HAVE BEEN FORTUNATE TO START OTHER COLORS.

IN 1987, WHILE BREEDING A SILVER LACED MALE TO A BLACK HEN, I SAW A CHICK WITH BIRCHEN COLOR MARKINGS. IT TURNED OUT TO BE A MALE. I CROSSED THIS MALE TO OTHER BLACK HENS BUT NO BIRCHEN COLOR SHOWED UP. THE MALES CAME BUT NO FEMALES UNTIL TWO YEARS LATER WHEN A BIRCHEN FEMALE FINALLY APPEARED. THAT HEN WOULD NOT LAY SO I FOUND A PEA COMB BLACK MIXED BIRCHEN FEMALE. NICE MALES CAME OUT OF THE BREEDING. SOME HAD PEA COMBS, SOME SINGLE COMBS. THE FEMALES DID NOT SHOW ALOT OF COLOR IN THEIR HACKLES. I A STILL BREEDING WITH THE MALES IF FERTILITY IS THERE. BUT THE FEMALES ARE STILL NOT COMING WITH COLOR.

PEOPLE ASK ME HOW I STARTED MY LARGE MOTTLES. ABOUT THE SAME TIME THE BIRCHEN MALE SHOWED UP, I STILL HAD MY BROWN LARGE. A FEMALE HAD SOME WHITE SPOTS ON HER HEAD AND THROUGHOUT HER NECK. I BRED HER WITH A BLACK MALE. SOME CHICKS WERE CLOSE TO BROWN IN COLOR WITH STIPPLING BUT TWO CHICKS, A MALE AND A FEMALE, CAME OUT CLOSE TO MILLE FLEUR PLUMMAGE (RICH BUFF COLOR FEATHERS WITH BLACK COLOR RUNNING TOWARD THE END OF EACH FEATHER FINISHING WITH SOME WHITE.) I CROSSED BOTH TOGETHER BUT NO MILLE FLEUR FOLLOWED, ONLY BLACK CHICKS WITH SOME WHITE SPOTS. I PUT THE FATHER, A BLACK MALE, ON THESE MOTTLE COLORED FEMALES. FEMALE OFFSPRING KEPT PRODUCING BUT IF A MALE COLORED BIRD DEVELOPED IT WOULD HAVE A CROOKED MIDDLE TOE. THESE MALES WERE INFERTILE SO A BLACK MALE HAD TO BE USED IN THIS BREEDING PROGRAM. IN 1990 THE BROWN COCHINS IN MY LINE ENDED.

What If...

HOW 'BOUT AN ALL COCHIN SHOW????????

YES, I THINK IT'S TIME TO START THINKING ABOUT AN ALL COCHIN SHOW. THAT'S ALL I EVER HEAR FROM THE BREEDERS THAT HAVE BEEN IN IT LONGER THAN I, "SHOULD HAVE BEEN THERE. THE ALL COCHIN SHOWS WERE REALLY SOMETHING.....

"'M SURE MOST OF OUR 120 MEMBERS WILL TRY TO EXHIBIT,,,,,,BUT THATS NOT WHAT IS GOING TO MAKE IT HAPPEN!

WE NEED TO FORM AN ALL COCHIN SHOW COMMITTEE.
WE NEED TO HAVE MEMBERS WHO WILL VOLUNTEER THEIR
FIME TO WORK AT PUTTING THIS SHOW TOGETHER. 1995
WAY BE THE YEAR TO AIM FOR.

- . A SITE. THE ALL COCHIN SHOWS BEFORE WERE HELD IN SOMONAUK IL JUST WEST OF CHICAGO. THE SITE OF THE ILL-MO SHOW HIGHLAND IL 30 MILES EAST OF ST. LOUIS HAS BEEN SUGGESTED. WHERE EVER WE GO IT WILL NEED AT LEAST 700 HOLES OF COOPING.
- OR A SUCCESSFUL SHOW. WE CAN'T EXPECT THE TOR A SUCCESSFUL SHOW. WE CAN'T EXPECT THE TORTHERN BREEDER TO DRIVE IN ICE OR SNOW SO THE NEED TO SET A DATE WHEN ROAD CONDITIONS WE FAVORABLE FOR ALL. APRIL 15 TO NOVEMBER 5 IS THE BEST TIME FOR GOOD ROAD CONDITIONS TO SHOULD BE ABE TO DECIDE ON A DATE IN THIS MONTH SPAN. ALSO, MOST FAIR PARKS ARE VERY BUSY PLACES AND WE WILL HAVE TO FIND ONE WITH AN OPEN DATE.

THIS WILL BE THE LAST NEWSLETTER FOR 1993 PLEASE REMEMBER YOUR 1994 DUES ARE DUE JANUARY 1 ST. THIS WAS SOMETHING THAT WE DISCUSSED AT COLUMBUS, RUNNING MEMBERSHIP FROM JANUARY 1 TO JANUARY 1. THEN ALL MEMBERS WILL KNOW WHEN IT IS TIME TO PAY THEIR DUES. SHOULD SOMEONE JOIN AT MID YEAR, HIS MEMBERSHIP RUNS ONLY TO THE END OF THAT YEAR AND HIS NEXT MEMBERSHIP IS DUE JANUARY 1ST.

LACK OF MEMBERSHIP MONIES IS WHAT FINALLY DISTROYED THE PAST TWO COCHIN CLUBS. MEMBER-SHIP MONEY IS WHAT WE USE FOR THE NEWSLETTER AND TO BY AND SHIP ALL AWARDS.

SINCE WE ARE SPONSERING A MASTER BREEDER AWARD PROGRAM, A MEMBER WILL HAVE TO FORFEIT THEIR MASTER BREEDER POINTS SHOULD THEIR MEMBERSHIP BECOME MORE THAN 4 MONTHS PAST DUE. APA AND ABA ENFORCE THE SAME RULE.

I COULD NOT GE THE MALES DARK ENOUGH, CLOSE TO DARK BROWN LEGHORN COLOR.

TO THIS DAY I STILL DO NOT HAVE ANY MALES WITH MOTTLED COLORING, BUT I DO HAVE MOTTLED FEMALES, I HAVE GOOD BIRCHEN MALES, BUT; THE BIRCHEN FEMALES EITHER HAVE GOOD TYPE OR GOOD COLOR BUT NOT IN THE SAME BIRD.

TO SUMMARIZE THE MINNICH BREEDING PROGRAM FROM WHERE MY FATHER LEFT OFF AND I TOOK OVER, I HAD TO OBTAIN SOME BLACK MALES TO PUT INTO THE PROGRAM. SO AROUND 1983 I OBTAINED 25 BLACK CHICKS FROM GEORGE PRIEST OF CALIFORNIA. THEY SEEMED TO HELP FOR THE FIRST COUPLE OF YEARS BUT THEN THE MALES STARTED DYING WHEN ONLY 3/4 GROWN.

THROUGH THE YEARS I'VE BEEN BREEDING CHICKENS I HAVE FOUND: YOU HAVE TO RAISE 20 CHICKS COMPARED TO 10 FROM THE SAME MATING TO GET ONE GOOD CHICK, PAIRING A GOOD FEMALE WITH A GOOD MALE DOES NOT USUALLY PRODUCE GOOD OFFSBRING, AND IF BOTH BIRDS HAVE THE SAME FAULTS THEY SHOULD NOT BE BRED TOGETHER.


