VICE PRESIDENT ELTON MINNICH OPENED THE MEETING THANKING EVERYONE FOR ATTENDING THE SHOW. MEMBERS GAVE ME A ROUND OF APPLAUSE. I THANKED PRESENT: TOMMY MOYER, DONALD WRIGHT, GEORGE SCHROEDER, PETER LUCA, KAT ST. AMOUR, EMMA MAY

WIGHTMAN, ROBERT SIMONS, DR. LORETTA SCHMIDGALL, ROBERT SOUTHERTON, MARTHA ANN GRIMER, JAY YOBST BRUCE ROBINSON, BRIAN JUSTICE, ELTON MINNICH AND OUR NEWEST MEMBER ANGELIQUE LIVEZEY.

CRAIG CARROLL DID NOT HOLD A WESTERN NATIONAL MEETING AT MASON CITY IOWA, SINCE ONLY 4 MEMBERS WERE PRESENT. I READ THE TREASURES REPORT RECIEVED FROM DENNIS WOLLARD. IT SHOWS \$1584.60 IN THE TREASURY WHICH INCLUDES PAYING THE AD IN POULTRY PRESS FOR NEXT YEAR. HOWEVER, WE WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR THE PRINTING AND MAILING OF THE BREEDERS DIRECTORY.

JEFF RYAN WHO IS HANDLING THE BREEDERS DIRECTORY, SENT A PROOF THE THE DIRECTORY TO SHOW OUR MEMBERS JEFF SAID IT SHOULD BE READY BY NOVEMBER.

UNDER DIRECTORS REPORT, I TALKED TO THE WALDAUS IN NEW YORK AND THEY WOULD LIKE TO BE REPLACED AS DISTRICT DIRECTOR. PETER LUCA AGREED TO DO THE JOB SO HIS NAME WILL BE PUT ON THE NOMINA-TION BALLOT.

PETER LUCA TALKED ABOUT CHOOSING OUR OWN JUDGES FOR A DISTRICT OR NATIONAL MEET EACH YEAR. WHAT IT WOULD DETAIL IS POLLING THE MEMBERS IN THE DISTRICT 4 TO 5 MONTHS IN ADVANCE OF SHOW DATE, MAKING A LIST OF 3 JUDGES IN CASE THE 1ST JUDGE WAS UNAVAILABLE TO DO IT. EVERYONE AGREED TO LOOK INTO IT.

T BROUGHT UP THE THOUGHT THAT OUR NORTHEAST DIS TRICT IS TO LARGE WITH 13 STATES. A MOTION WAS MADE BY GEORGE SCHROEDER, SECONDED BY PETER LUCA THAT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS VOTE ON SPLITTING THE NORTHEAST INTO 2 DISTRICTS. CONNECTICUT, MAINE, MASSACHUSETTS, NEW HAMPSHIRE, RHODE ISLAND, VERMONT, AND NEW JERSEY. THEN DELAWARE, MARYLAND, PENNSYLVANIA, VIRGINIA AND NEW YORK THE OTHER. THE MAIN REASON IS THE DISTANCE FROM MAINE TO VIRGINIA.



HINTS FROM HEN-OISE

IF YOU WANT TO BAND CHICKS UPON HATCHING, AN EXCELLENT (NO FALL OFF) BAND CAN BE MADE FROM CUTTING A TWISTER SEALER FROM BAGGIES, IN HALF. SHAPE AROUND A PENCIL SO IT LOOKS LIKE A POULTRY BAND. OPEN SLIGHTLY. PLACE AROUND CHICKS LEG. CLOSE BY PUSHING TOGETHER AROUND LEG. THESE CAN BE WRITTEN ON, ON THE INSIDE.

TO KEEP CHICKS FROM DROWNING IN THEIR WATER DISHES, IF YOU DON'T HAVE THE DROWN PROOF KIND, WASH SMALL STONES AND PLACE IN TROUGH.

IF YOUR TRAVELING TO A SHOW AND IT'S STIFLING HOT ADD PLASTIC SODA BOTTLES HALF FULL OF FROZEN WATER TO EACH CRATE OF BIRDS. (CAUTION..MAKE SURE THE BIRD IS LARGER THAN THE BOTTLE!)

SUNLIGHT (NOT NECESSARILY DIRECT) HELPS COMBS AND COMB POINTS STAND ERECT.

GIVE 2 WHEAT GERM GEL CAPS PER WEEK TO OLDER BIRDS, TO AID IN FERTILITY. (WET AND THEY SLIDE DOWN EASILY.

TO AGE A COCKEREL OR COCK EASILY, WIGGLE THE SPUR. ON AN OLDER BIRD THE SPURS WILL NOT WIGGLE

RAISE CHICKS ON CLOTH SO THE LEGS DON'T SPLIT AND THE TOES DON'T TURN.

ALWAYS BROOD UNDER RED OR YELLOW LIGHT TO PREVENT BLINDNESS IN CHICKS.

WD40 IS EXCELLENT TO PUT ON THE UNDER CHIN FEATHERS, IF LICE EGGS ARE PRESENT. THIS WILL SMOTHER THEM AND PREVENT HATCHING.

DON'T PULL WING FEATHERS ON BLACK CHICK-ENS, OR IT WILL COME BACK WHITE TIPPED. CUT OFF HALF WAY DOWN AND LET DIE FOR 2 WEEKS, THEN PULL.

LOTS OF CHICKS HATCHING TO KEEP TRACK OF? MARK HEADS AS THEY HATCH WITH COLORED MARKERS. MARK THE EGG THE SAME COLOR.

CORE OF LETTUCE IS GREAT FOR CHICKENS

BUTTERMILK TO MAKE AN EGG MASH IS EXCELLENT IN THE WINTER. ALSO CAN HELP WITH SOME FORMS OF COCCIDIOSIS.

BE AWARE THAT BAROMETRIC PRESS EFFECTS YOUR THERMOSTAT IN YOUR INCUBATOR.LOW PRESSURE LOWERS TEMPS AND HIGH PRESSURE RAISES. (MAY BE ONLY SLIGHTLY BUT CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE ON VERY HIGH OR VERY LOW PRESSURE)

ADAMS FLEA MIST WORKS EXCELLENT ON ANTS

ON A HOT SUMMER DAY IF YOU ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THE HEAT IN YOUR POULTRY BUILDING, PUT A SPRINKLER ON THE ROOF. IT CAN LOWER THE INSIDE TEMPS 10 - 15 DEGREES.



HASTE MAKES WASTE OR CONSIDER IT AS A VALUABLE LEARNING EXPERIENCE!

BY DENNIS WOLLARD

THIS PAST SPRING I WAS IN A HURRY WHEN TAKING SOME CHICKS OUT OF THE HATCHER. I QUICKLY, BUT CAUTIOUSLY WEB MARKED THE CHICKS WITH A PAIR OF SHARP SCISSORS ACCORDING TO THEIR LINEAGE. (I'VE LEARNED TO BE VERY CAREFUL AT THIS STAGE OF THE GAME BECAUSE I "REALLY" MARKED ONE CHICK BY CUTTING OFF A TOE. ANY WAY, AS NATURE HAD IT, THE CHICK WAS NOT A KEEPER FOR CHAMPION ROW AFTER ALL.) I QUICKLY PLACED THE CHICKS IN THE STANDARD THREE LEVEL BROODER. THIS BROODER HAD A WIRE BOTTOM, HOWEVER I FEEL THAT THE WIRE SQUARES ARE TOO LARGE AND ROUGH ON THE CHICKS FEET, SO I USUALLY PLACE A PIECE OF OLD SOFT CLOTH IN THE BOTTOM FOR A FEW DAYS UNTIL THEY GET SOME SIZE ON THEM AND LEARN HOW TO WALK. THIS DAY HOWEVER I DID NOT HAVE THE SOFT CLOTH HANDY, SO I PICKED UP SOME OLD NEWS-PAPER AND IN THE BACK OF MY MIND I FELT THAT I MIGHT HAVE SOME PROBLEMS WITH SPRAD-DLE LEG CHICKS, AND SURE ENOUGH AS THE GRASS TURNS GREEN IN THE SPRING TWO CHICKS IMMEDIATELY WENT DOWN. THIS WAS CERTAINLY MY FAULT AND I WAS NOT GOING TO LOOSE THESE IT WAS LATE SPRING AND I HAD HAT-CHICKS. CHED VERY FEW CHICKS SINCE I WAS HATCHING FROM HENS, I CERTAINLY DID NOT WANTTO LOOSE CONSIDERING POSSIBILITIES TO THESE TWO. TRAIN MUSCLES TO HOLD THE LEGS TOGETHER, I CONSIDERED SOFT COTTON STRING, DUCT TAPE,

AND OTHER THINGS TO ACCOMPLISH MY GOAL. THEN I THOUGHT TO USE A FLAT (1/8 INCH WIDE) RUBBER BAND AND SUPER GLUE TO MAKE A RING TO ALLOW EACH FOOT TO PASS. I PROCEEDED TO CUT THE RUBBER BAND SO THAT IT WAS ONE FLAT PIECE/STRIP OF RUBBER. NEXT I MADE A LOOP WHICH WOULD ALLOW ONE FOOT TO PASS WITH THE TOES POINTED FORWARD. THIS LOOP WAS SECURED WITH THE SUPER GLUE. I NEXT PICKED UP A "NORMAL" CHICK TO DETERMINE THE WIDTH OF THIS CRUTCH/SPLINT. AFTER TAKING A MEASUREMENT I PROCEED TO MAKE A LOOP ON THE OTHER END OF THE RUBBER BAND AND SECURED IT ALSO WITH SUPER GLUE. NOW THE RUBBER STRIP, CUSTOM MADE, HAD BEEN DISIGNED TO HAVE TWO LOOPS ON EACH END AND SECURED WITH SUPER GLUE. I THEN HELD THE TOES TOGETHER AND SLIPPED THE LOOPS ONE ON EACH TO EACH LEG. THIS ALLOWED THE CHICKSS LEGS TO BE IN PROPER PLACE, HOWEVER THEY STILL COULDN'T WALK. AFTER SEVERAL ATTEMPTS THE CHICKS LEARNED TO WALK AND WERE WALKING EVERY BIT AS GOOD AS THE OTHERS. I WAS ANXIOUS TO

SEE IF THE EXPERIMENT WORKED, AND WANTED TO REMOVE THE SUPPORT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SO THE BIRD WOULD NOT GET TOO USE TO THE SUPPORT. AFTER JUST TWO DAYS, I TOOK OFF THE RUBBER STRIP BECAUSE I KNEW THAT IT COULD BE EASILY REPLACED IF NEEDED. IN JUST TWO SHORT DAYS, THE TWO BIRDS COULD

WALK AS GOOD AS ANY OTHER CHICK. I NOW MAKE SURE THAT CLOTH ONLY IS USED, HOWEVER I KNOW THAT I DO HAVE A OPTION TO SAVE THESE CHICKS IF IT IS MY FAULT BY NOT PLACING THEM ON A ROUGH SURFACE.
