





Editor's Notes:

Hello everyone!

Winter is upon us and so is the fall/winter show season. Some of you have already set up your breeding pens for the coming breeding season, so that you can get those birds out early and in full feather! No matter whether you hatch early or late, the whole evolution of putting together your breeding pens, collecting the eggs, setting them and marking the chicks when they are born, all the way through rearing them to young adults is what makes our hobby so much fun. On a yearly basis, you get to see the fruits of your labor. You find out whether your matings improved the attribute you wanted them to, or whether you took a step backward and have to rethink your breeding strategy. That's what keeps us going; the lure of that perfect bird out there on the horizon. Will there ever be a perfect Cochin? I doubt it, but there will be some that are pretty darn close, and then you have to factor in each person's definition of the perfect Cochin. The two standards spell it out in black and white and then each of us has our own interpretation. Those interpretations are open to debate and that is often the case in Cochin aisles around the country. You've seen them at the shows. The two noteworthy breeders off to the side in professor like debate over their successes or disappointments in that year's crop of youngsters. Or they'll be discussing a particular bird, pointing out to each other their likes and dislikes about the specimen in question. And then when they can't come to an agreement or have a difference of opinion on a particular subject they'll poll a third party and get them in on their conversation! Yes indeed, that is what makes this hobby so much fun. We have our experts and we have our novices that will someday be experts. The only way to become an expert in this hobby is through experience. It is not something you can go to school to learn, unless you want to acknowledge the school of hard knocks, and it is not something that can be bought or sold. It is one of those things that have to be earned. That I think is one of the things that hooked me on the poultry fancy. When I started showing poultry in 4-H I had a little bit of everything. I had Polish, Cochins, Sebrights, Wyandottes, Leghorns, Silkies, Frizzles and who knows what else. I just liked taking them to the fair and shows around the area and getting that elusive Blue Ribbon! I think one of the things that also helped me as a fancier is that I participated in as many Showmanship contests as possible, both at the 4-H level and at the Poultry Shows. I was even lucky enough to go to the New York State Fair a couple of times to represent Ulster County! I can't recollect how well I did, but the experience gained from those endeavors is priceless. I encourage anyone with children interested in Poultry to get them involved at the 4-H level. Your local Cooperative Extensions have a lot to offer.

I guess my whole point in the above paragraph is that I am glad that I am a part of this hobby and not something else. The general public as a whole is unaware that we even put together shows for purebred poultry on any given Saturday or Sunday, and are happy to go to Denny's for their Grand Slam breakfast instead! We on the other hand get up at 3 am and drive 300 miles so we can get cooped in on time! What a life!! I haven't even mentioned the friendships that are made through our hobby. I have known Al Zielberger, a Wyandotte and Sebright man from Monsey, NY, since I can't remember, but it has to be right around 25 years. We keep in touch via phone calls when I am at my Dad's and now via email, and I saw him again at the Eastern New York State Poultry Association Show in Cobleskill, NY on 30 September. He looks exactly the same, but the thing that struck me the most about seeing him again was that right there along side him was John Chambers. John is a Sebright man of some renown and it dawned on me that over these past few years, I hardly ever see one of them without the other. Why, because they are friends! They enjoy our hobby and they travel together! We got to talking and the subject of John's age came up. John is 93 years young! I want to be showing Cochins when I am 93! What a great hobby!

I had the pleasure of attending the Eastern New York State Poultry Association Show on the 30th of September. In fact I got up there on Saturday to help Jamie and Terri Matts and the ENYSPA folks set up for their show. I had a great time and I stayed overnight Saturday at Jamie's place. We were out in the barn until almost midnight going through Cochins! I refer to the previous paragraph.....what a great hobby! The show was well attended and had some very nice Cochins entered. In fact Jamie had both Champion Featherleg and Champion Asiatic on a White Cochin Pullet and a Black Cochin Pullet respectively. My father and my step-mom Kathy came up to the show and I had originally planned on my being there to be a surprise, but my father managed to find out I was going to be there. It all worked out great anyway and Sunday afternoon I followed them back down to Wallkill and stayed until Tuesday morning. I wanted to get to see my parents before I came over here to Turkey. How a Cochin is Like a Cheetah

Cochins are usually slow, calm chickens that don't like to move, right? WRONG!! They are calm and usually slow, but my bantam black cockerel runs in short, but very fast bursts when he wants to. Cheetahs also run in short spurts (no more than 20 seconds or they could possibly overheat and die) at 71 MPH. My cockerel does not move quite that fast.

I let him out of his hutch in the morning. After being stuck in there all night, my cockerel hops out and waits until I disappear around the side of the barn to get him some water. Then he sprints out of his pen and around the barn corner, sees me, stops, and pretends to be very interested in the dirt beneath him (he really doesn't like to dash around while people are watching).

We have a 6" high and 5" wide rock border around our chicken area. My cockerel's short sprints can take him right over this border smoothly without touching it. He just skips a step and without slowing down or unfolding his wings, he hops over. He never sprints for more than 5 or 6 seconds with- out stopping and looking around (he likes to tilt his head back and look straight up and see what's above him).

We have a standard size Dominique hen who is mean and bossy to all chickens smaller than she is. One morning when she was out of her pen eating, my cockerel happened to "run" into her. When she started to try to peck him, he jumped up and down like a prize fighter to avoid her pecks until I came to break up the fight.

So don't be fooled by your Cochin's calm disposition or slow movements. He or she may be a cheetah at heart too.




