





Things have been going well in the district and I had the opportunity to visit a few shows this fall. Tops on my list, was the Eastern National Show in Knoxville, Tennessee. Lots of bantams at the show but the large fowl were sparse with only 16 birds being shown. I know it is an expensive endeavor to raise the big birds but we need to have more individuals working on the LF. There were over 300 bantams entered at Knoxville and the quality was quite deep.

The Cochin Club has seen a little disagreement by a few of the membership over who should and shouldn't have voting rights in the membership. Currently we have the elected officers and District Directors that vote. That said, we all have to realize that clubs are products of their membership and we need to hear from the membership on any important issue before decisions are made. Personally, I have been rethinking how my breeding program is being run. In the past, I've hatched birds out in the late winter (February and March) one time per year. I'm now experimenting by hatching out some birds earlier (December) with the intention of hatching some more out in March. Over the years, I've observed that my large fowl are in prime showing shape somewhere b 7 and 8 months of age for the females and about 9 to 10 months for the males. By splitting my hatchings, I'm hoping to have better birds to show over a longer period of time. I hope it works and I'll let you know how I make out.

I certainly hope all the cochin members in NE District II have a great upcoming breeding season and see a lot of improvement in their birds. Remember to encourage a kid into the fancy and never be to busy to offer some words of encouragement and advice. Until next time I send you all my best. Rich

#### **Knoxville TN 2013 Cochin National Report by Troy Laroche:**

First I want to thank the exhibitors for having me judge your birds. The classes were a joy to handle. I did all the Bantam Cochin classes. I will mention the Large Fowl, although I did not judge them, I did go look at them for Best Cochin Overall. Nice birds and continue the good work. I do believe that Clell Agler judged them and he could go over the results of what he found in these classes rather than me.

In Bantams, an overall comment; I was most impressed with the wings in a large percentage of the birds. In recent years, I have detected in my travels a tendency for weak wings in many of the cochins I see. Not the case in the majority of the specimens in Knoxville. Some top notch birds in most all colors with good sound wings were found in most all varieties.

Highlights for me were the Blacks and Whites. Most of these birds could and probably have won shows throughout the nation. The Black Hen I picked for Best of Variety and Best of Breed was outstanding with good type, conditioning and the ever impressive good wings. A well balanced bird all over. A close second was a Black Cockerel that was Reserve of Variety and Reserve of Breed. He too was a sound bird in all aspects and well balanced. Whites were another good class with outstanding quality throughout. My only negative comment some were a bit yellow. But other than that. A great class of quality throughout.

Several other notables were the Mottled in both Blue and Black. Nice birds with great potential. Another highlight was the Frizzles. Many good specimens in a couple of color varieties with a class of white pullets standing out in the crowd. Several other varieties were shown in a host of standard and non-standard varieties. It is good to see the progress of these Varieties and work that is continuing to make them closer to the standard.

One of my favorite parts of judging is seeing progress especially in the rarer varieties. I must comment on one non-standard variety with that being the Splash. Some awesome typed birds were shown in this class. Once accepted I feel they will be contenders for the top. I was pleased to have the other judges that took part in the Feather-Leg judging unanimously put the Black Cochin up for Best Feather-Leg. The Reserve was a struggle with an outstanding Reserve of Breed Cochin, a great Silkie and a Duccle that never stopped showing and eventually going on to be Reserve Feather-Leg. Not to mention several others (Langshan, Booted, Brahma and Faverolle) that also were in the running made for some tough voting and decision making in the end. # **Recognizing Splash Cochins By Bruce Robinson**

Cochins International is leading the charge to have the Bantam Splash variety admitted to the American Poultry Association (APA) and American Bantam Association (ABA) Standards.

As part of that process, we are required to certify to the APA that we have held two successful meets where there were at least 2 cocks, 2 hens, 2 cockerels and 2 pullets on exhibit. We completed the first certification at the ABA National Meet / Cochins International Eastern National Meet on December 7 & 8, 2013. The Splash Cochin Bantams on display – 20 total, including 3 cocks, 4 hens, 5 cockerels and 8 pullets – were all of good breed type and none were disqualified. Special congratulations to Linda Merrell for winning Best and Reserve of Variety!

I am proposing to host the second APA certification meet at the Southern Ohio Poultry Association show in Lucasville, OH on Memorial Day weekend – May 24-25, 2014, and encourage everyone with Splash Cochin Bantams to enter their birds at this show. Following the second certified meet we will forward our petition and proposed standard to the APA along with the required fee. If accepted, the APA qualifying meet would be held in Columbus, OH on November 7-9, 2014 – this meet requiring at least 50 birds and 5 exhibitors.

I am also currently working the ABA requirements and am asking for our membership to send me high quality digital photos – cocks, hens, cockerels and pullets. I will compile them and include as an attachment to our application, along with the fee. Please email photos to <a href="mailto:bbosshoss@msn.com">bbosshoss@msn.com</a>. The proposed qualifying meet would also be at the Ohio National on November 7-9, 2014.

The proposed color standard will match the existing ABA description for Splash plumage:

<u>PLUMAGE</u>: Slaty-blue and white that has a faint gray tinge. Blue in feathers in the form of large irregular shaped blobs as distinct from V-shaped ticking. Main tail feathers and primary wing feathers with a lesser amount of blue than the rest of the plumage.

**<u>UNDERCOLOR</u>**: Slaty blue and sooty white, evenly distributed.

<u>DISQUALIFICATIONS</u>: Any appearance of rust in the plumage - More than 50 percent blue in plumage. This is a team effort and everyone's assistance is necessary in order to make this effort successful: (1) If you raise Splash Cochin Bantams, please hatch a few extra this year and plan to exhibit them at the Ohio National so we can meet our 50 bird minimum, (2) A donation of any amount would help offset the application fees – PayPal donations can be made to email <a href="mailto:cochinsint@gmail.com">cochinsint@gmail.com</a>, and (3) If you are near Columbus and would be willing to receive birds from out of state and get them to the show, please let me know.

# CI Special Meet - Master Breeder Program

We have a well-established Master Breeder Program, whereby members earn points based on the number of Cochins exhibited at shows which host Cochins International meets. There are currently two Master Breeders point total recognition levels. Upon achieving 100 points in any given variety a Cochin Breeder receives a Certificate of Achievement. Master Breeder status is earned upon reaching 500 points in a variety and a plaque is awarded to recognize this achievement.

Points are accumulated as follows:

Master Breeder upon achieving 500 points in no less than five (5) years.

One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Best and Reserve of Variety.

One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Best and Reserve of Breed.

One point is earned for every five Cochins exhibited for Overall Champion (FL and Bantams).

There must be at least five Large Fowl and five Bantam Cochins in competition.

The points are awarded for the highest win an individual bird earns in its class.

A Certificate of Merit will be awarded for the first One Hundred points in any variety.

Master Breeder status is earned upon reaching 500 points in a variety and a plaque is award to recognize this achievement.
