All birds must be tested for Pullorum-Typhoid within a year and for Avian Influenza within the past ninety days. The sale of untested birds is prohibited.

ENTRIES:

Entries close Oct 15th or when cooping capacity is reached. Entry fees are \$3.00 per bird. Double coops (for large fowl only) are \$6.00 and must accompany entry. Make checks payable to Kay StAmour, 2017 Castleton Rd,. Darlington, MD 21034

All birds must be cooped in by 9:00 on Sat Nov 3rd. For your convenience the show hall will be open about 4 PM to 8:00 PM Friday. The show hall will open at 7:00 AM Sat. Judging to start at 9:00. The show will end Sunday at 9:00 or immediately following the short awards ceremony.

CAMPER HOOKUPS:
